### ***2013 Celebrating Leadership in Development Excellence (CLIDE)***

The Center of Development Excellence is excited to announce the sixth cycle of the biennial CLIDE Awards program. We are looking for projects and programs from our region that exemplifies the Principles of Development Excellence. Applications for the 2013 CLIDE Awards will be accepted online from January 31- March 15, 2013. Applications will need to be submitted through this website. Awards will be presented to the recipients at the North Central Texas Council of Governments' General Assembly on June 14, 2013.

Please consider submitting an application for that outstanding project, program, or policy in your community that exemplifies the Principles of Development Excellence. We hope that you will join us as we recognize those outstanding projects and programs in our region that will help us ensure a sustainable North Texas.

Begun in 2003, CLIDE Awards recognize projects, developments, and private or public programs that exemplify the region's Principles of Development Excellence. During the 2011 CLIDE Awards cycle, 16 recipients from among 40 applicants were honored at the North Central Texas Council of Governments' General Assembly.

### ***2013 CLIDE Awards Categories***

Awards will be distributed in the following categories with emphasis on the Principles of Development Excellence. All five categories are open to all eligible entities, organizations, and individuals, including both public-and private-sector entities.

The following categories are applicable for the 2013 Awards cycle. Note: the Awards Jury reserves the right to determine the number of recipients for each category.

- New Development
- Redevelopment
- Special Development
- Raising Public Awareness
- Public Policy and Planning

### ***2013 CLIDE Awards Jury***

A distinguished panel of jurors comprised of nationally respected professionals in the fields of architecture, planning, and development, will select the CLIDE Award recipients from the applications submitted. Winners will be notified and invited to the North Central Texas Council of Governments General Assembly on June 14, 2013 where the awards will be presented.

### ***2013 CLIDE Awards Eligibility***

The following eligibility requirements apply to the 2013 Awards cycle:

- Only online submissions will be accepted;
- All applications must be received by the submission deadline of March 15, 2013;
- Submissions will be accepted from both public and private sector applicants;
- Joint or team applications are encouraged (where applicable). All major project participants should be identified and will be recognized;
- Competing applications for the same project or activity will not be accepted;
- Submitted projects or activities must be in the North Central Texas region;
- Submitted projects or activities must exemplify or promote one or more of the Principles of Development Excellence and must promote the mission of the Center of Development Excellence;
- For an entry in the New Development, Redevelopment, or Special Development categories, the project must, at minimum, be under construction by the submission deadline;
- For an entry in the Public Policy and Planning category, the program/policy/plan must be adopted by the local government by the submission deadline;
- For an entry in the Raising Public Awareness category, the program/campaign/publication must have been aired/published/distributed by the submission deadline.

### **Basic Information**

1. Please enter the Project or Activity Name.
2. Please choose the Development Excellence Category for which your Project applies. Depending on which category is chosen, you may be asked one additional question subsequent to this one.
  - a. New Development
  - b. Redevelopment
  - c. Special Development
  - d. Raising Public Awareness
  - e. Public Policy and Planning
3. Project Start Date.
  - For an entry in the New Development, Redevelopment, Special Development categories, the project must at least be under construction by the submission deadline of March 15, 2013.
  - For an entry in the Raising Public Awareness category, the project must have been aired/published/distributed by the submission deadline of March 15, 2013.
  - For an entry in the Public Policy and Planning category, the project must have been adopted by the submission deadline of March 15, 2013.
4. Project Applicant Information (Name, Title, Organization, Address, Phone, Email, etc.)
5. Primary Project Contact Information (if different from above)
6. Project Contact Information (if different from above). This includes specific location information.

If you indicated that you have additional documents that you wish to submit, a CLIDE Awards representative will contact you in the next few business days regarding these documents. While the initial project application deadline is March 15, all information in addition to the online application will be due by 5:00 pm on March 22, 2013. **Please do not wait until the last day to send materials.** We have size limits on email attachments, so close coordination between CLIDE Awards representatives and project applicants may be required.
